Programs Available to Residents

Founded in 1980, The MENTOR Network is a national network of local human services providers offering an array of quality, community-based services to adults and children with developmental disabilities or acquired brain injury; to children and adolescents with emotional, behavioral and medically complex challenges; and to elders in need of home care.

Barranger Group Home, Greenridge House, Bayview – Lynn Haven, Gulfview, and Seaview are six-bed ICF/IIDs which are similar to 6-bed group homes. These programs are converted single-family homes within community settings. The Pensacola Cluster has three separate units with 4 semi-private rooms each, which specialize in medical care for residents.
