Programs Available to Residents

- **PARC's Adult Day Training** program offers a variety of choices for residents who can base their decision on their interests, skills and talents. Unique adult programs include recreational, learning, and work opportunities in a supervised environment.
- 
- **PARC's Center Industries** provides work for individuals to earn a paycheck based on a piece rate or hourly wage. Values are encouraged throughout the work program.
 - **PARC's Life Enrichment Program** offers opportunities for adults to integrate and participate in community activities, as well as training in areas of basic academics, self-care, daily living, social skills, communication and more.
 - **Job Placement/Job Coaching** provides time limited coaching programs that target successful employment for adults with disabilities.
 - **Supported Employment** offers continued employment support services that help individuals enhance their existing job or advance careers beyond entry-level positions.
 - **Specialized Day Programs** include the **Fine Arts Programs**, the **Adult Technology Achievement Center** and the **Cultural Arts Center** covering hobbies, performing arts, visual arts, etiquette, sports and other activities.
 - **Behavior Services** offers multi level services of Behavior Analysis and Behavior Assistant. The goal is to decrease behaviors in the individual's life whether at home,

on the job, in the community or in a Day Program. Strategies are developed to increase positive interactions within the individual's daily activities.

Staff

PARC's ICF/IID's staffing consists of 24 hour Direct Care staff, PCA provides 24 hour nursing care. PARC's ICF/IID's also provide a strong managerial, auxiliary, and consultant staff.

Unique Features



PARC's ICF/IIDs have choice centered characteristics providing person center choice to the residents, along with a personalized environment. PARC has its own transportation department and the ICF/IID's have

their assigned fleet of vehicles. PARC's ICF/IID's are centrally located in southern Pinellas County providing easy access to St. Petersburg. PARC is fortunate to be offered frequent opportunities to attend local professional sporting events to include the Rays and Buccaneers, and local cultural arts events.
